Leading African Women in Food Fellowship (LAWFF)

Launched in 2023, this 6-month program, funded by the Skoll Foundation, targets African women 25-45 years with ≥3 years of experience in the agri-food sector to build a dynamic network of entrepreneurs, chefs, policymakers, storytellers, ecosystem enablers, and innovators. The LAWFF fellowship continues to amplify African women food-system leaders through the LAWFF Advocacy Tool (LAV Book), a 5-episode “Women Feeding Africa” podcast, and continent-wide alumni events that strengthen sisterhood and cross-border collaboration.

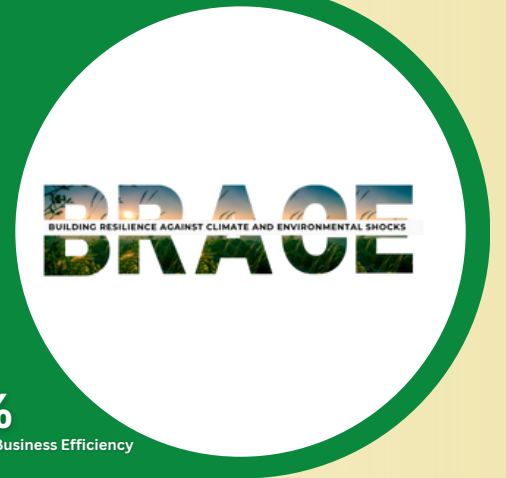

Advancing Climate-Smart Agriculture and Strengthening Resilience Across Africa with continued support from the Skoll Foundation, AFC successfully delivered the 2025 Building Resilience Against Climate and Environmental Shocks (BRACE) program through three hybrid learning cycles that combined self-paced modules, live sessions, M&E training, study visits, and expert advisory to boost climate-smart agriculture and resilience for agri-food SMEs across Africa.

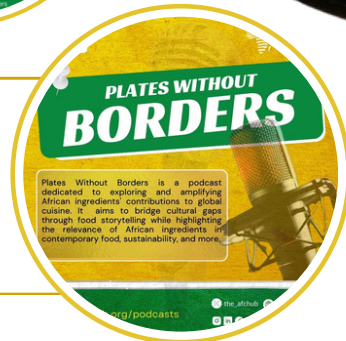
